

Diversions under Fund 6
(All Figures are for the Biennium)

%25 gas tax toward the available school fund - \$1.5 billion -Enacted in the 1940s at the inception of the state tax

Office of the Attorney General - \$1.7 million

\$1.7 million for the biennium from the State Highway Fund for litigation expenses related to the conversion of mineral rights on state property. Fund 6 does not get any of the funds recovered and state property does not need to be highway ROW. - Enacted in 1986

Department of Public Safety - \$1.144 billion

\$44.4 million for the biennium from the State Highway Fund for Border Security is new. The \$1.1 billion is for highway enforcement. Enacted or diversion started in 1986

Automobile Theft Prevention - \$27.6 million For grant activities and administration of auto theft prevention. However the \$1 fee for each auto insurance policy collected in state for this purpose is deposited to GR, not fund 6. Diversion started in 2004

Commission on the Arts - \$1.34 million. Diversion started in 1998.

Historical Commission - \$1 million. Diversion started in 1998.

Health and Human Services - \$20 million. Diversion started in 2006.

Texas Education Agency - \$100 million. Diversion started in 2006.

Texas Transportation Institute - \$13 million. Diversion started in 2002.

Border Security - \$100 million

These diversions total \$2.9 billion
