2	Size of groundwater plume in cubic feet	The size of groundwater plume is 233 million cubic feet. This number was derived by using 45 feet as the depth of the saturated zone multiplied by 5,184,375 square feet of the contaminated groundwater plume area.

8	How much is in the National ASARCO trust?	As of the end of January, \$7,769,539. However, this money is almost all budgeted to be paid out as reimbursement for claims. The trustee has given recipient parties until March 2, 2009, to file for reimbursement for calendar year 2008. As background, the consent decree calls for eight equal principal installment payments of \$12.5 million plus interest on the remaining principal not yet paid. Each installment is due May 31 of each year, beginning May 31, 2003.
