Located in the heart of the Chihuahuan dessert, El Paso is uniquely dependent on the Rio Grande and certain groundwater resources for its 50-year water supply. Our agenda:

Protect El Paso interests on rule of capture and interbasin transfers Secure grants for desalination plants to serve Fort Bliss and El Paso Require that groundwater sales or lease proposals from Permanent School Fund and Permanent University Fund lands meet all competitive bidding requirements

Allow the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to regulate rates associated with the selling of water from a pipeline that transports water
